## For clarification regarding the Deductible and Co-insurance

Please reference the chart shown on last month's Talking Points. Please note: there is a correction that should be noted for the Ford Protected Plan enrollees. The current information is as follows: "There is no change in the out-of-pocket amounts for 2009. However, the out-of-pocket maximums for out-of-network services should read: For the Ford Protected TCN Enrollees, the maximum is \$285 single/\$570 Family; for the Ford Protected PPO enrollees, the maximum is \$1,000 single/\$2,000 Family."

## January 2010 Letter from Medical Benefits Trust

If a UAW retiree received any letter stating their medical coverage was terminated, this does not necessarily mean that the coverage was cancelled. If the retiree did not submit payment for the 2009 retiree medical coverage, the new coverage through the UAW Retiree Benefits Trust was not activated on January 1, 2010. However, the retiree may request reinstatement retroactive to January 1, 2010 by contacting Retiree Health Care Connect at the following number:
