# Patient Centered Medical Home Designation



2010 - E-Prescribing is an expected requirement for PCMH designation

2009 - Quality Performance (EBCR measures)

- Resource Management (GDR, ER, Imaging, IP)
- Practice attributes / Initiatives
- Patient experience, if available

# PGIP Expansion



- In 2009, all sub-specialty participation will need to be through primary care-based physician organizations.
- All physician members of a practice unit should be represented by a single physician organization.
- Planning for Hospitalists (2008) and Nephrologists (2009) is to be represented through contracted PGIP organizations.



- BCBSM is generally developing and implementing common capabilities, such as e-Prescribing, in parallel with POs.
- How can we promote collaboration and avoid duplication and fragmentation in these activities?



- In 2008, BCBSM would like to work with POs to 'clean up' the denominators of the EBCR measures.
- What would be a good process to collaboratively improve this data?
