- Launch of Corktown Training Institute as a formal program in 2022
- Focused on the development of online training aimed at Primary Care Providers
- Developed in collaboration with WSU School of Medicine and subject matter experts from the LGBT community
- Currently, three modules are available online, with CME credits of 1.25 each
- Currently available modules are: *LGBTQ Health 101* and *102* as well as a module on *Increasing Use of HIV Pre Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) in the Primary Care Setting*.
- Additional modules are in development for release later in 2024 and include the following topics: *Improving Care for GBTQ Older Adults*, and *Improving Care of Transgender and Gender Nonbinary Adults*.

## Goals

- Increase awareness about LGBTQ health issues in Michigan and convene robust discussions on LGBTQ health topics for educational and training purposes
- Continue to offer a wide range of training content at <a href="www.corktownhealth.org">www.corktownhealth.org</a>
- Offer facilitated training conducted by licensed health care providers as appropriate
- Future sessions will be developed on emerging topics and expressed needs of stakeholders
- Explore the development of an online directory through which patients and others could find the name of an affirming medical practice close to their home
- Foster collaboration among LGBTQ organizations to share local information, collect essential data on health needs, and encourage the delivery of LGBTQ focused medical services in their communities
- Develop value for health care organizations by providing a conduit for ongoing learning
